### THE PETER MARSHALL FRENCH STUDENT CENTER

Dedicated in 1978 by Robert and Shirley French (Trustee Emerita) and their family in honor of their son, Peter Marshall French, the student center has, ever since, served as a lively central hub for students to congregate, learn, exchange ideas, and forge lifelong friendships. However, the needs of today's campus community have significantly outgrown the current building. A reimagined, renovated, and expanded student center is a key funding priority within the Academy's comprehensive fundraising campaign, *With True Courage, The Campaign for Governor's*.
